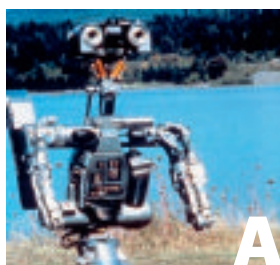
Rise of the machines

A robot army is coming to the London Science Museum

The robot revolution is upon us: our metal friends are fast overtaking their human creators as the world competes to make evermore complicated, mechanical versions of ourselves. But have you ever wondered where our fascination with robots comes from? It's the question the London Science Museum's new exhibition Robots, running from 8 February-3 September, is hoping to answer. 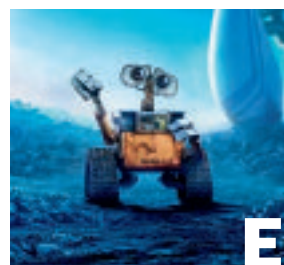
