The water that fully embraces Greek Islands eventually makes its way to the San Francisco Bay, then pulls across to a Hong Kong Pier and is cooled in the Scandinavian fjords. Far apart, the tides bring these women together.

**THE 5 OF US MET** at the physical theatre school Dell’Arte International in California where we were trained as actor-creators in ensemble based theater. As a group we found each other and developed a strong way of working together. **WE, THE SIREN ENSEMBLE**, devote ourselves to the intersection of art, movement and the element of water. We envision ports as an opportunity to celebrate this intersection as a place to exchange stories and cultures and a place to create unexpected encounters and connections. The Sirens embrace diversity in all forms, their performances are spoken in different languages, but become accessible because they express themselves through the language understood by everyone; movement -The language crosses all barriers and unites us as human beings.
